| 1. Where do babies come from? | 1. They grow in mothers |
| 2. Did I grow inside mother? | 2. Yes |
| 3. Where did you get me, mother? | 3. You grew inside of me. |
| 4. Where do hospitals get babies | 4. They don't get babies they help mothers. |
| 5. How do babies get out? | 5. Through passageways inside the mother to the outside |
| 6. Can I see the place on you? | 6. No, I'll draw a picture |
| 7. Can I have a baby? (girls – boys) | 7. Yes, when you are grown up and married. |
| 8. Why can't we have a baby? | 8. Doctor says wait, must plan for, money needs. |
| 9. Does it hurt to have a baby? | 9. Some, but mothers gladly do it, doctors help ease the pain |
| 10. How long does it take to make a baby? | 10. Nine months |
| 11. Why is Mrs. So & So, so fat? | 11. A new baby is growing inside her. |
| 12. Do people get sick with babies? | 12. Sometimes, but most of the time mothers are happy |
| 13. Can you feel the baby inside? | 13. Yes, he moves before birth |
| 14. How big is a baby inside? | 14. Grows from a speck to orange, grapefruits, melon, etc |
| 15. How does a baby breath inside? | 15. Doesn't need to – part of air and food provided by mother. (Root to plant analogy) |
| 16. How does a baby eat inside? | 16. Same as #15 |
| 17. What does being born mean? | 17. Coming out of mother's body into the world |
| 18. How big is a baby who is born? | 18. 7 pounds, 18 – 20 inches long |
| 19. Where do babies come out? | 19. Passage opens between water tube and rectum |
| 20. Do I have a passageway? (girls and boys) | 20. Yes |
| 21. How do you tell when a baby is ready to come out? | 21. You can feel muscles pushing baby out |
| 22. Why must there be a father too? | 22. Always, father cell and mother cell equal baby |
| 23. Where do fathers keep their cells? | 23. In to little glands in a sac. Draw scrotum |
| 24. Where does it come out of the father? | 24. In the same opening water comes out |
| 25. How do mother and father cells get together? | 25. Father plants, or mother and father cells fit together |
| 26. What did you do to get a baby? | 26. We do it by mating. We love each other. |
| 27. Could I see you do it? (mate) | 27. No, that is our own private business |
